


Franck Innocent (rouen 1912-1983), Landscape: The Eure At Pont De l'Arche, Rouen, Oil, 1979

He was a member of the Artistes Rouennais (Rouen Artists) at the age of 15. His painting is colorful and free, he paints on location with great freedom.
