Description

Large floral composition Original oil on canvas Signed lower right VINCELET Dimensions: 106 X 70 cm and 134 X 96 cm with frame French painter from Puy-de-Dôme, Victor VINCELET was born into a family of food merchants. He went to Paris to study painting with Antoine Vollon, a Lyonnais painter specializing in still lifes, and Didier Alphonse L'Huillier. Despite a relatively short life, he exhibited at the Salon and was very successful with many fans of floral paintings. The painter offers us a large floral composition, magnificent peonies and wallflowers are presented in a porcelain jardiniere decorated with gilded bronzes, very fashionable in the 19th century. The brightest colors contrast with the whiteness of the peonies, illuminating the dark background of the painting. Another
