## Description

Oil on canvas signed lower right. In a luminous and golden palette, Alfred Chagniot tenderly captures a summer harvest scene in the Paris region. Sheaves of wheat, peasants, and their horses enliven this serene landscape, vibrant with warmth and rural life. The balanced and lively composition demonstrates an eye sensitive to the values of the land and the simplicity of everyday life. This painting perfectly illustrates the figurative style of Alfred Chagniot, a direct heir to the teachings of Pierre Eugène Montézin and Édouard Vuillard, whose students he studied. He

became a member of the Salon des Artistes Français in 1938 and received numerous distinctions, including the Marie-Bashkirtseff Prize in 1941. A retrospective of his work took place in 1993 at the Château de Croissy. A painter rooted in the French landscape tradition of the 20th century, Chagniot is part of the lineage of sincere observers of the rural world, at the crossroads of poetic realism and a warm naturalism.
