Description

A finely made antique Meissen porcelain lidded box, decorated in rare black enamel with the iconic "Ming Dragon" motif. The dragon -- five-clawed and imperial in type -- is shown chasing the flaming pearl among stylised red clouds. This composition belongs to the renowned "Chinesischer Drache" (Chinese Dragon) series, one of Meissen's most recognizable and collectible decorative patterns.

The box is marked with Meissen's crossed swords in underglaze blue and includes the red decorator's number to the interior. The lid and body both show crisp enameling, precise brushwork, and gilded detailing -- a testament to the high level of craftsmanship that defines Meissen porcelain.
