Description

A ceremonial mask with a powerful expression, adorned with frontal horns, side rope braids, and polychrome areas. Typical of the Wé (Guéré) peoples of western Ivory Coast, this type of mask embodies a bush spirit, used in rituals of justice, protection, or initiation. The bright colors and mixed materials (wood, fibers, textiles) reinforce its visual and symbolic effectiveness. The half-open mouth and half-closed eyes emphasize an ambivalent presence, both social and spiritual.
