Description

Wooden male figure, standing in a dynamic posture, his eyes encrusted with glass. The half-open mouth, the assertive gesture of the right hand, and the dark residue visible on the neck and torso refer to intense ritual use. This type of sculpture is a nkisi: a fetish "charged" by a nganga (healer-priest), intended to act in the visible world. Whether for protection, healing, or justice, it is a direct intermediary with the spirit world. The glass eyes symbolize the ability to see beyond, to pierce hidden truths. An inhabited piece, designed to respond to the living.
