Crafted in sterling silver (925) and marked with the classic dotted oval "GEORG JENSEN" hallmark alongside "925 S" and "Denmark", this brooch exemplifies timeless Scandinavian craftsmanship. Originally designed by Georg Jensen himself circa 1915-1925, this particular piece was produced post-1945 by the Georg Jensen Silversmithy using the original molds. The design showcases a delicate arrangement of grape clusters and leaves enclosed in a softly rounded oval frame -- a motif symbolic of abundance and nature, deeply rooted in the Art Nouveau tradition.
