Elegant oval-shaped, double-sided, silver reliquary medallion, featuring two hand-painted religious miniatures under glass. This personal devotional object, dating from the late 18th or early 19th century, was intended to accompany its wearer in prayer and spiritual protection.
Description: Side 1: Depicts Saint Francis of Assisi, identifiable by his Franciscan habit, the cross he holds in one hand and the skull (memento mori) in the other, a symbol of penance and meditation on death. This iconography corresponds to the style of Baroque representations of the saint. Side 2: Depicts the Virgin of Mount Carmel, carrying the crowned Infant Jesus. Both hold scapulars, emblems
