Edouard Cazaux (1889-1974) is a sculptor and ceramist. Coming from a family of potters from the southwest of France, he set up his workshop in Varenne-Saint-Hilaire in 1918 and participated in numerous exhibitions: Tuileries, Artistes Décorateurs, Salon d'Automne, including the International Exhibition of Industrial and Modern Decorative Arts of 1925. He exhibited his works
