Description

Base and capital for double columns in Burgundy limestone. From the 12th century, transition from Romanesque and Gothic art, sobriety characteristic of the Cistercian style. Coming from the abbey of Cîteaux in Côte d'Or (Burgundy) near the town of Nuits Saint Georges. These two architectural elements were positioned in one of the cloisters of the abbey Notre Dame de Cîteaux, a large part of which was demolished during the Revolution! The stones having been resold to the inhabitants of the surrounding area. Base dimensions: length 40 / width 24 / height 20cm Capital dimensions: length 40 / width 24 / height 10cm
