



Dining Room Sideboard In Mahogany, Gilt Bronze, Turquoise Blue Marble - Restoration Period



Description

Beautiful sideboard in flamed Cuban mahogany veneered on oak. The keyholes are adorned with rich chiseled and mercury-gilt bronze trim. Topped with turquoise blue marble, it rests on ball feet with rounded uprights. It opens with 2 doors and 2 drawers in the belt, the left one fitted with compartments for storing silver cutlery. Parisian production in the Empire style and Restoration period, early 19th century, 1820s-1830s. The very high quality of this chest of drawers in the use of luxury materials including the impeccable assemblies and the interior of the doors, the case entirely mounted on a beautiful blond oak with regular grain, the very beautiful chiseled and gilded bronze trim, the luxury marble are undeniably the signature of one of the greatest Parisian cabinetmaking
