Elegant set of three nesting tables, all signed "Prodhon - Paris France" under each top. A creation of the house of Louis Prodhon, a Parisian cabinetmaker active in the 1950s-1970s, known for his high-quality neoclassical furniture. Tops in exotic wood veneer (probably rosewood), with dense grain and a glossy finish. Simple molded frames. Fluted gilt brass legs, inspired by the Louis XVI style, finished with tapered sabots. Each table is stamped on the reverse: "Prodhon -Paris France". Dimensions: - Large table: 51 x 30 x 48 cm - Medium table: 41 x 29 x 44 cm - Small table: 31 x 28 x 29 cm Overall condition: very good.
