Inscribed on the back "Done at Nogent-sous-Coucy le Château on May 20, 1808. E Pingret pinxit." Edouard Pingret was a French painter born in Saint-Quentin in 1785 and died in Paris in 1869. He studied painting with Jacques-Louis David and Jean-Baptiste Regnault then at the Academy of Saint-Luc in Rome. He exhibited at the Salons from 1810. French school of the early 19th century. Oil on canvas. Relined. 19th century gilt frame.
