He regularly collaborates with major luxury and interior design houses, notably Hermès, for whom he creates unique pieces combining technical rigor and artistic flair. His work has been praised by numerous institutions, and he is a winner of the Grand Prix National des Métiers d'Art. His works are now featured in several public and private collections, in France and abroad.
