The typographic printing was entrusted to the Coulouma printing house in Argenteuil. Printed in 499 copies + 25 HC, 1 of the 5 non-commercial copies on Japon Impérial (N°1) including a black suite of hors-textes and chapter headings, signed in pencil by the artist. Attached on loose leaves, the subscription form, 4 pp. in-4°, including 1 hors-texte, slightly creased. By the great Brunelleschi, the color rendering is absolutely breathtaking on Japon Impérial, worthy of the original drawings, MAGNIFICENT.
