Dynamic figure of Mephistopheles, one of the main characters in Johann Wolfgang Goethe's drama. The figure is depicted playing the mandolin and singing a serenade, and his dance movements are emphasized by his upwardly flowing robe. Auguste de Wever (1836-1910), Belgium - author of several works depicting the figure of Mephistopheles, probably created after seeing an opera based on Goethe's work.
