A beautiful gold patterned paper adorns the rest of presentation. Work from Northern Europe, Germany, Flanders, Hanse, circa 1740. Beautiful crowned coat of arms, eagle and rearing horse... 29cm x 17cm x 13cm. Weight: 2kg. Condition: Overall good, but: some scars on leather are hidden, (red arrows), hasp is apparently not original, but it has the merit of existing, lock does not work, and above all: the cutlery is missing!
