Léon-Auguste MELLÉ (1816 - 1889)The Corniche Road to GenoaOil on wood panel signed lower left and titled on the back.(Cartouche on the frame)Léon-Auguste MELLÉ was born on April 15, 1816 in Paris. He was a student of Jules COIGNET (1798-1860) and Charles-Caius RENOUX (1795-1846). He regularly appeared at the Paris Salon between 1839 and 1879 with views taken in Switzerland, Dauphiné, Picardy and the surrounding area of Paris. This view of a seaside landscape animated by sailboats titled on the back "the cornice road to Genoa" suggests that he also traveled to Italy. Dimensions including frame: 61.5 x 43.5 centimeters.
