Maurice Josselin, active in France in the early 20th century, is known for his elegant figures of dancers, often in motion, which reflect the ballet and cabaret culture of the Art Deco period. His works generally feature fluid lines, graceful anatomy and a sense of kinetic energy, which is found in this sculpture.
