

Portrait Of A Young Girl - Late 19th, Early 20th Century - Drawing



Description

This drawn portrait of a young girl seen in profile, testifies to the remarkable mastery of the artist, who, like his model, remained anonymous. The face, with its delicate features, finely outlined, is rendered with great sensitivity: the artist captures both youth, innocence and a certain meditative gravity in the young girl's expression. The modeling of the face is subtle, playing on shadows to give volume and animate the flesh. The hair, long and falling freely, is treated with a contrasting density, reinforcing the sculptural aspect of the head. The gaze, although turned towards the horizon off-screen, seems concentrated, adding an introspective dimension to the work. The tight framing and the neutral background highlight the subject without distraction. The choice of profile, often associated
