Nakago Funa Gata and Ha Hagari Kuri Jiri ('irregular U'), signed Hizen Kuni (No) Ju Mutsu (No) Kami Tadayoshi. Etchu-kise-habaki in copper covered with gold. Wooden Saya, covered with mordoré marbled lacquer. Kojiri and Sei in copper covered with shakudo and enhanced with gold; engraved with foliage motifs. Koi guchi and Kuri gata decorated en suite. Copper shitodome. Wooden tsuka, covered in shagreen and woven with black silk. Menuki representing two shakudo kakemono with gold tassels. Copper fuchi covered in
