



# 18th-century Chest Of Drawers Stamped P. A. Galligne



## Description

A delightful small chest of drawers, stamped P. A. Galligne for Pierre-Antoine Galligné, who became a Master on October 5, 1767.Curved on the front and sides, it opens with four drawers in three rows and is adorned with marquetry of rosewood reserves on an amaranth background, high lighted with fillets. It is topped with a pinkish-gray marblemolding with a bec-de-corbin following the curve of the front and sides. Finely chiseled and gilded bronze trimon the drawers and base, as well as on the pinched front uprights,topped with corner drops, and on the feet mounted with sabots. To complete its charm and elegance, its small proportions (H. 87 cm x W.87 cm x D. 47 cm) are noteworthy, making it a pleasant living room piece. The P. A.
