



## Wrought Iron Gates And Property Gates, Napoleon III - 19th Century.

### Description

Important park gate forged in the mid-19th century, in very good condition, from a property in the south of France in Bouc Bel Air. With a height of 320 cm and a total length of almost 10 m, its openings offer a passage of 320 cm. Originally, this gate, set between stone pillars, is ensured for its stability by two remarkable inverted volute struts. The whole is riveted and the crossing bars are pinned. For its transport, the side gates were cut to a length of 225 cm, the remaining meter being still integral with the pillars and the undismantled leaves, including its toe plates. Its original ground stop is provided. H = 320 cm Lg gate =  $166.5 \times 2 + 1 \text{ cm} = 332 \text{ cm}$  Lg grilles =  $101 + 225 \text{ cm} \times 2 = 551 \text{ cm}$  Lg total = 986 cm H upper rail = 288 cm P at the struts = 120 cm Section of gate uprights = 55
