Description

Striking hand-painted glazed porcelain sculpture of a roaring tiger in a seated position, likely made in Italy between the 1950s and 1970s, within the decorative tradition of Italian ceramic workshops active during the mid-20th century. It is reminiscent of the grand-scale zoomorphic pieces by Capodimonte or the artisanal ateliers around Bassano del Grappa.

The anatomically precise modeling, combined with a high-gloss glaze and extremely realistic painting, gives this piece a powerful and vivid presence. Every detail - from the pronounced musculature to the open jaw with fangs - has been executed with exceptional craftsmanship. The bright green eyes, carefully rendered striped coat, and dynamic stance accentuate the tiger's power and capture the artisan's technical excellence.
