Description

Iranian wool kurk rug, circa 1970. Good condition, some old restorations (see photos). Borders and stop stitches restored. Beautiful Véramine on a blue background, in mianfarsh format in kurk wool (fine wool taken by combing from the necks of lambs). This great classic is made with the 'mina khani' motif (daisy motif). Four small "hérati" borders frame a wider border featuring the "samovari" and boteh* motifs. These five borders highlight the entire rug. It is becoming difficult to find Véramine rugs in this dimension. *Boteh: Ancient motif with different meanings. It can represent the transformation of Zoroaster into a cypress, symbol of eternity, but also into a drop of water, a palm tree, or a tree. The term boteh means "flowering bush" in Persian. There is a similarity with yin and yang.
