SHIKORO (neck cover) with four levels in glossy black lacquered iron and blue and orange silk braid. FUKIGAESHI (small fins) in glossy black lacquered iron covered in stamped deerskin and decorated with orange silk. MABI SA SHI (visor) in wrought iron covered in stamped deerskin.
