She wears sumptuous garments, including a fur-lined mantle and richly draped robes, symbolizing her royal status and noble spirit. Her right hand rests on her chest--a gesture of devotion--while her left holds a quill (a symbol of wisdom), and near her is a spiked wheel, the attribute of her martyrdom. The painting can be dated to the 17th century, a period known for the Baroque style, and it displays stylistic features
