Below, two paneled doors with finely detailed brass escutcheons open with a working key to reveal a single interior shelf, providing functional storage while preserving the clean lines of the Louis-Philippe style. The cabinet stands on "pistolet" feet, and the construction is mortise and tenon, ensuring solidity across generations.
