Pair of stained glass windows on cathedral glass, painted with enamels and grisaille, featuring a decor of vegetation (wisteria, trumpet berries, roses) and tits. Stained glass windows attributed to Ponsin. Wooden frame. Perfect condition. Joseph-Alfred PONSIN (1842-1899) active in Paris between 1878 and 1884. Joseph-André PONSIN, also called the "Vitrarius," was a comedian and songwriter. He became a renowned master glassmaker in the last quarter of the 19th century. He notably decorated Sarah Bernhardt's mansion and is exhibited at the Carnavalet Museum. Width: 103 cm. Height: 197 cm. Width of a panel: 51.5 cm. Period: late 19th century.
