



Mailbox, Tahan In Paris, Napoleon III Period.



Description

Elegant rectangular box with softened angles, made of rosewood veneer, joined in a diamond point on the top, enhanced with a fine frame of gilt bronze beads. The whole rests on four gilt bronze feet with vegetal decoration. The lid, decorated with a longitudinal slit, indicates that this box was intended to receive mail, tickets or dispatches - it is therefore a correspondence box, also called a dispatch box, typical of elegant interiors under the Second Empire. A central medallion in painted porcelain, with a sky blue background, framed in rocaille gilt bronze, represents a rich bouquet of polychrome flowers. The interior, lined with its original moiré fabric (in used condition), opens with a lock signed "TAHAN à Paris", famous tabletterie house and official supplier to Napoleon III and Empress
