Condition: creases, small losses and irregular edges, but the drawing is clearly legible.

This luminous sketch shows a young woman in prayer, her hands delicately clasped and her face surrounded by a radiant halo. The purity of line and introspective calm evoke a spiritualist aesthetic, echoing the Pre-Raphaelite tradition and the neo-medieval sensibility found in certain strands of late 19th-century Italian religious art.
