Philippe Albin de BUNCEY - Goundi. Original Art Deco graphite pencil drawing (subject: 140 x 100 mm) signed lower right, on paper (270 x 345 mm) from a spiral notebook, presented under a mat (300 x 400 mm). Ctenodactylidae (Ctenodactylidae), goundis or gondis, are a family of small rodents found in Africa and whose classification is still debated (Wikipedia). Philippe Albin de Buncey (1905-1978), French sculptor and animal designer. Student of the painter and sculptor Edouard Navellier, member of the French Artists; silver medal in 1937 (Universal Exhibition). At the Salon d'Automne he exhibited animals, until 1936 (Bénézit).
