in this way in Greek literature. In Norse mythology, the fox is an animal associated with Loki, the Scandinavian god of mischief and discord. In the mythology, literature and folklore of East Asian countries, the fox spirit is said to be an animal with supernatural abilities, such as metamorphosis, possession, mastery of the elements or the ability to pass from a material to immaterial state, becoming an equal of the deities with immense powers, generally in the form of a nine-tailed fox, which can become a creature sometimes beneficial, sometimes malevolent. In Japan, the fox is associated with Inari, the deity of crops and industry. W
