Description

Splendid oil on canvas painting depicting the famous Tivoli Waterfalls, executed by the English painter Arthur John Strutt, a prominent figure of 19th-century landscape painting connected to the Grand Tour, and dating to around 1870. The work offers a poetic and luminous rendering of the Lazio countryside, much loved by Romantic travelers and foreign artists active in Italy during the 19th century. The well-balanced composition captures the dramatic force of the waterfalls through a masterful use of light and color. In the foreground, a group of travelers walks along a path immersed in greenery, adding a delicate narrative element to the scene. In the background, amid the cascading waters, one can glimpse the monumental remains of ancient Tibur, with its architecture

harmoniously integrated into the landscape. The precise, naturalistic brushwork, combined with a Romantic sensitivity to atmosphere, fully reflects Strutt's stylistic hallmark--an artist who dedicated much of his life to documenting the landscapes, costumes, and views of central Italy. The painting is set in a fine, coeval giltwood frame, richly carved, which enhances its decorative impact. Condition: very good. The canvas is stable, the paint well preserved, and the signature is clearly legible at the bottom.
