Exceptional oil on canvas mounted on a wooden panel by the painter Reneé Tourniol 1876-1953, born in Limoges on May 10, 1876 and died on January 20, 1954 in Royan. French orientalist painter. Between 1900 and 1940 she traveled through North Africa, the Sahara was close to her heart (Tamarasset and Djamet in Algeria) at the Salon des Artistes Français in 1927. Exhibitions in Algiers in 1930. And died at the age of 77. Here is a very large canvas with a camp at the gates of a village in the background. Family scene with child and preparation of the meal. Very beautiful pictorial technique! Magnificent colors with warm tones, with dominance of ochre and brown hues. Masterpiece of the artist with this very beautiful oil signed and located in Msab.
