



## Louis XVI Table Clock, Dial Signed "drouot à Paris"



## Description

This elegant Louis XVI table clock, crafted from gilded bronze and white marble, dates back to the late 18th century and is from France. A work of great elegance and decorative refinement, it features a carved white marble structure and a base embellished with finely chiseled mercury gilded bronze applications. The allegorical scene above the dial depicts Diana, goddess of the hunt, discovering the sleeping young Endymion, inspired by Greco-Roman mythology. The two figures in dark patinated bronze are rendered with great dynamism and attention to detail. Diana, armed with bow and quiver, rests her foot on a moving golden cloud, while Endymion rests on a rock next to his faithful dog, in a serene and idealized pose. The circular enameled dial features Roman numerals for the hours and Arabic
