Description

This fascinating Art Deco sculpture was created in France around 1930; based on a design by Georges Gori, creator of exotic dancers and elegant Art Deco figures, who worked in Paris between the 1920s and 1940s. In this work, despite the classical theme of motherhood, Gori does not focus on the tenderness of an embrace, but rather captures stylized movement through gestures and poses, just like the young mother's dress, fitted to the torso and pleated at the hem. The elegant pose of the figure and the delicacy of her dress are rendered with striking precision. Georges Gori (active 1920 - 1940), metal, ivoirine and onyx, signed on the base "G.Gori".
