This type of work is specific to Indo-Persian decorations, respect for symmetry is accompanied by a deep concern for perfection of the chiseled elements. Many flowers, roses, peonies, lilies, mix with interlacing and foliage. The slender baluster-shaped piece has great stability due to its

weight, and the base of the feet with a diameter of 17 cm. The piece is in superb condition, circa 1900, 61 cm high and weighing 7.2 kg. The last photos show other objects from our collection.

Pure copper is the origin of the alloys bronze and brass. It has been shaped by repoussé at all times, but it has often been gilded, enameled, covered or inlaid with other materials like our model. It has been used extensively in the manufacture of everyday objects.
