Description

Anatolian rug, wool, wool warp and weft, circa 1950. Good condition. The stopping points have been restored in our workshop. Solid and durable rug. Located in western Anatolia, the small town of Kozak is about twenty kilometers from the city of Bergamo (Western Turkey, Aegean region). The name "kozak" derives from the word kazak, a mountainous area including Georgia and Armenia (Caucasus). Many Turkish rugs since the 19th century have been made by Armenians under the supervision of Armenian Ustads (Master weavers). On a plain red 'kazadé' background, a medallion with zoomorphic shapes stands out, and on both sides, certainly, 'trees of life' motifs. All around, a border features zoomorphic motifs (ram's horns, wolf's mouth). Free Chronopost delivery for France and Europe. Do not hesitate to
