Superb large Ubanga Nyama Lengola statue from Congo
Solid wood with a crusty patina in places
Remains of colored pigmentation of small round spots
The large Lengola veneration statues are known as Ubanga Nyama. They were erected in the center of the village after the death of a chief. These minimalist sculptures are supposed to represent the founding ancestor of the Lengola, Suway. Such statues having been used are rare
They were erected in the center of the village after the death of a chief. They could also be used during initiation rites of the Butoko society. These statues can be dismantled, possibly for storage or portability
Over time, the color of the pigments of the patina has faded, a crusty patina has set in places
