Description

Female head, possibly a deity or dignitary of the Majapahit court, Sumatra, 13th/15th century. Made of tuff, a volcanic rock formed by the accumulation of ash and debris thrown up during eruptions. Although the Majapahit kingdom developed from Java, it features a stylized headdress from Sumatran art of the period as well as large ear rings. The kingdom expanded into Sumatra in 1377 by annexing Sriwijaya. This head is therefore to be placed at the end of the 14th century.
