This farmhouse table features a typical 2nd half of the 19th century style with curved legs tapering downwards and a scrolled apron, indicating an influence from the Louis XV style. It is made of cherry wood, a species commonly used at that time. The extensions indicate that the table was designed to be extended to seat 10 to 16 people, very practical for large family gatherings. The sides are decorated with faux drawers with turned wooden knobs.
