Yujo-habaki in copper covered with silver.Wooden Saya, covered in black lacquer and glittered with green.Blue sageo.Kojiri, Kuri gata, Koi guchi, Fuchi - signed Yoshiaru and Kashira in silver shibushi covered with shakudo, chased with a pearled rough sea.Copper shitodome.Wooden Tsuka, covered in shagreen, braided with navy blue silk.Kogatana with Kotsuka in silver covered
