Edo period (1603-1868) Early 17th century Steel, wood, lacquer, silk, shakudo, gold, copper Nagasa: 52.1 ; Nakago: 13.1 cm Sori: 1.4 cm (Old damage)? Kata Shinogi blade, Mune Hikushi, Chu Suguha temper line. Nakago Funa Gata and Ha Hagari Kuri Jiri ('irregular U'), signed Echigo no kami Kanesada. Yujo-habaki in copper covered with silver. Wooden Saya, covered in black lacquer and glittered with green. Blue sageo. Kojiri, Kuri gata, Koi guchi, Fuchi - signed Yoshiaru and Kashira in silver shibushi covered with shakudo, chased with a pearled rough sea. Copper shitodome. Wooden Tsuka, covered in shagreen, braided with navy blue silk. Kogatana with Kotsuka in silver covered
