Vanitas is a recurring theme in art, especially during the Renaissance period, often present in still lifes, portraits, and religious art. This type of work invites us to reflect on our own existence, the fragility of life, and the importance of living with awareness and meaning, focusing on spirituality rather than earthly riches. The wooden skull sits atop a gilded wooden base with an iron flower on the back. Dimensions with base: height 23 cm, width 28 cm. Dimensions without base: height 16 cm,
