18K yellow gold ring with Roman emerald pearl.
Roman pearl work, 1st-2nd century AD. Modern
setting in 18-carat gold (eagle's head hallmark).
Ring size(can be easily resized) : 5.75 (US)

L (UK) 51 (EU) 3.37 g.

This type of pearl was made by cutting a natural
emerald prism into several sections which were
then drilled. This ring model is inspired by the
rings of the late Hellenistic period of the 2nd-1st
centuries BC. The pearl is supported by a
gadroned rosette on both sides as well as a fine
spiral gold wire. Superb ring, particularly refined
and elegant. Excellent condition.
