Set of two photographic plates in negative on glass, each mounted with a second opalescent glass plate on the reverse, enabling them to be read in positive by backlighting or by presenting them against a light background. Each object is framed and of different dimensions. First negative (small format) Outdoor family scene, group of people photographed in a wooded setting. Typical of amateur or family shots taken in the late XIXe century or very early XXe century. Framing: ornate gilded brass frame, to be suspended by chain. Second negative (large format) Photographic reproduction of a religious illumination from a medieval antiphony. The scene depicts the Adoration of the Magi, with details of the neumatic notation typical of early liturgical music. Framing: hammered metal frame
