Description

André PRUGENT (1882-1965), oil on cardboard representing a winter sunset in a wooded landscape of the Périgueux region; it is signed A.Prugent at the bottom right. It is a typical work of this painter who sought to translate with an impressionist touch and a subtle color palette, the winter atmosphere in the Périgord countryside. Dimensions: oil on cardboard 23.5 cm x 17.5 cm -- frame: 27 cm X 21 cm. André Prugent practically never left his town of Périgueux. He attended the drawing school whose director was the painter Jean-Louis Daniel who made him his favorite, so much so that at 18 he was already exhibiting his paintings at the Société des Beaux Arts. On returning from the war he took up his brushes again: he loved to find himself in the Perigord countryside with Emile Chaumont,
