Louis-Philippe period double-barreled pistol, circa 1830-1850, 19th century. Percussion pistol with a polished white steel case. Smooth-bore barrels in 13 mm caliber and 13.5 cm long, with sights, a "V" rear sight and a ball-shaped front sight. Crested hammers with thumb checkering. Double trigger under the trigger guard and individual for each barrel. Metal ramrod with a brass tip in the shape of a nail, under the barrels. Barrels marked 8 at the height of the chamber and on the frame at the height of the trigger guard. Functional single-action mechanisms. Walnut frame with a round and flat cap and the monogram "M. D".
