Aubusson tapestry "The Hot Hand" in wool and silk belonging to the series of "country amusements" made according to the cartoons of *Jean Baptiste Huet after those of **Jean Baptiste Oudry for the Royal Manufacture of Beauvais. In the foreground we see four figures playing the game of the hot hand, a young woman sitting on a bench and three young men, one bent over with his hands behind his back and the other two standing. The scene takes place in a green landscape with trees. Original border in good condition (resized and top border previously replaced) This tapestry is fully lined with its hanging rings.
